Laxman is a cheerful and active student who engages during class. He is talkative and expressive, but his

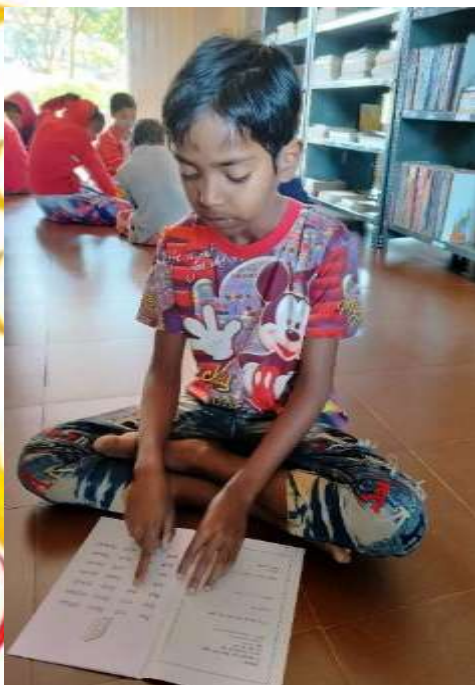

HINDI:

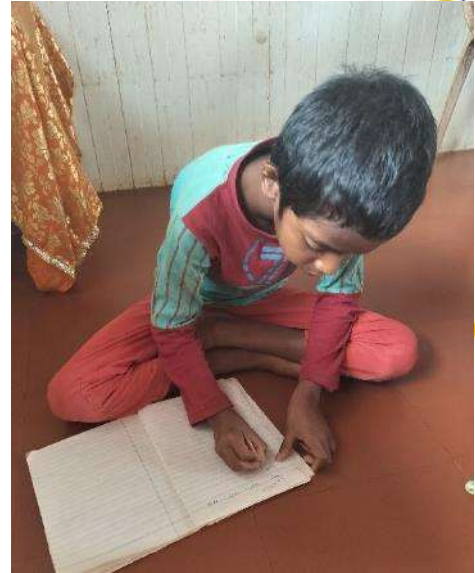
