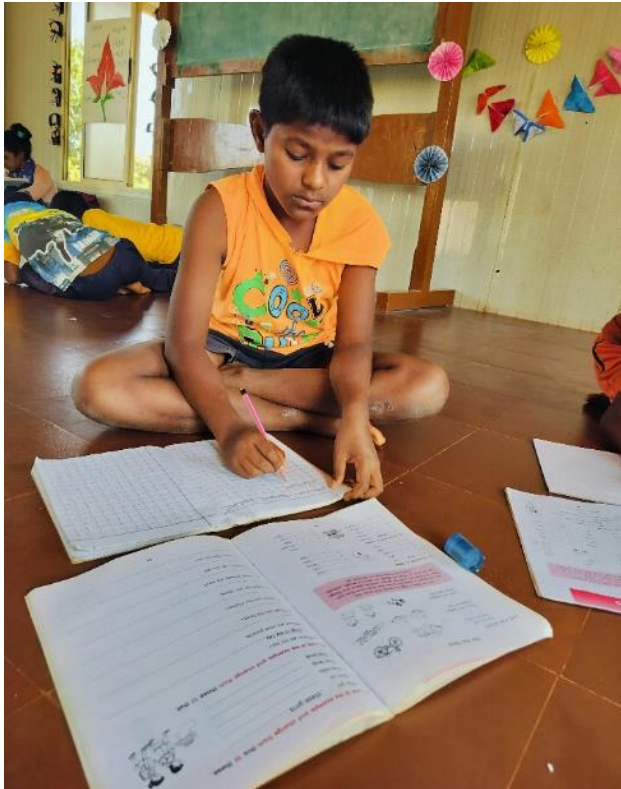


# Sanat Jani

**Report for 2023-24 (Second Term)**



**Mathematics-** Sanat, an intelligent student studying from the fourth-grade textbook, diligently attempts to answer all questions accurately. He faces challenges in grasping fractions, particularly the concept of equivalent fractions, as it is a new topic for him. Sanat also encounters difficulties in multiplication due to occasional lapses in remembering multiplication tables. Despite these challenges, he demonstrates a strong determination to concentrate and excel in class.

**Projects-** Sanat bicycle topic was very exciting and enthusiastic for Sanat. Growing up in a village environment, he has seen many elderly and youngsters riding bicycles. He was eager to ride a bicycle himself and asked many questions to understand how to ride it. He eagerly completed all the assigned work on time and consistently learned the parts of the bicycle in about two classes. He remembered all the parts of the bicycle and could correctly identify





them, although he had difficulty with the pronunciation of "spokes," pronouncing it as "spokas." With perseverance, he succeeded and pedalled the bicycle, with two friends holding him to balance. He also studied the history of the bicycle and its modifications throughout the centuries. Under the teacher's observation, he made a model using cardboard and paper, and his model could roll like a real bicycle. He also created riddles related to the topic and shared them with his group. He showed patience while making the models, holding the cardboard until it was securely stuck. His enthusiasm and happiness in small achievements
