

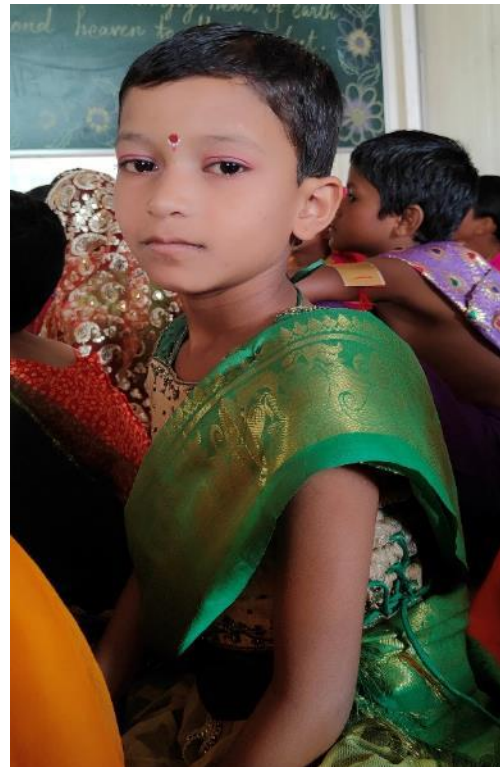
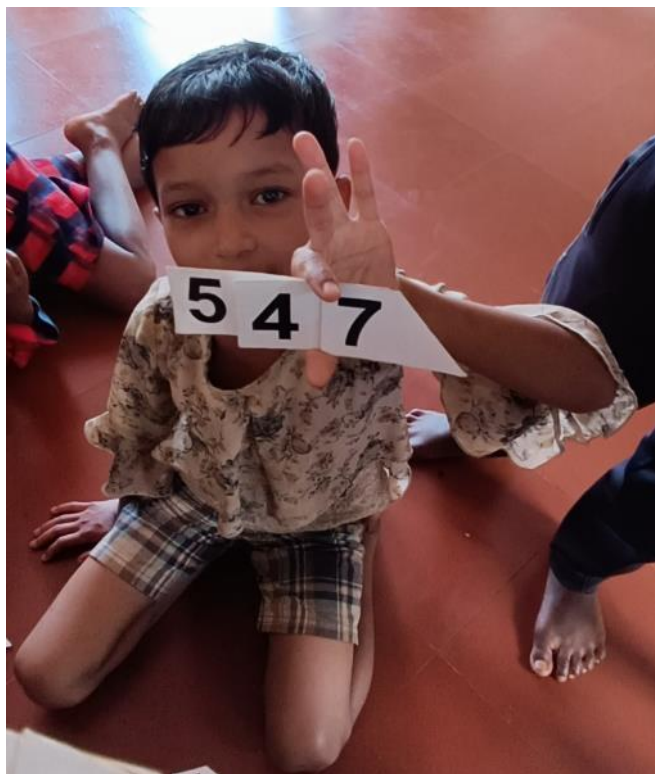

Mathematics

Arts & crafts

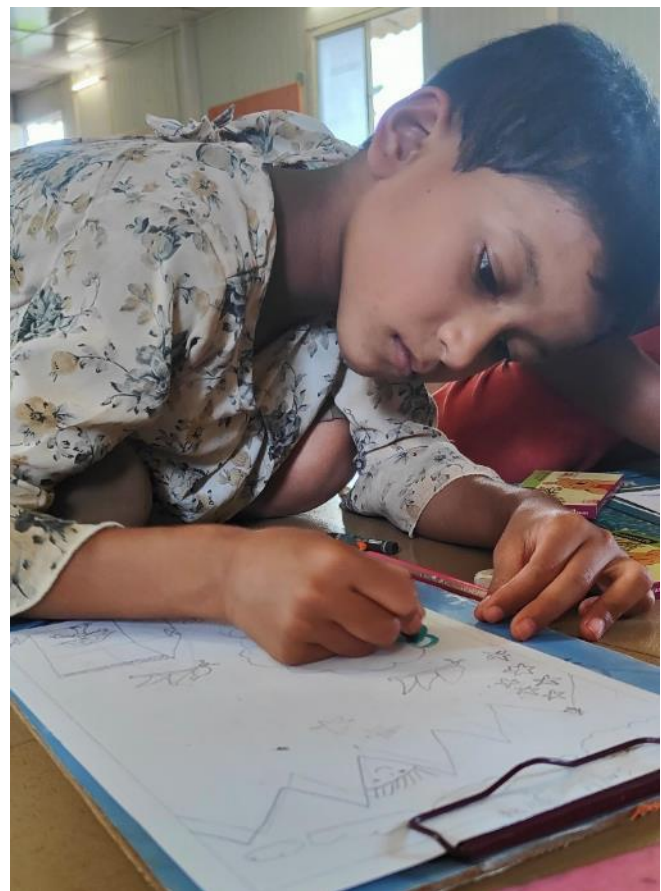
She is good at arts and concentrates while doing the different activities in the art class. She enjoys doing all the activities but
