Shubechha is a cute girl who attends school regularly. She is a neat and clean child with occasional lapses. She is able to do all her daily chores independently and is toilet trained. During mealtimes, she sits and finishes her food and eats all the vegetables. During Circle time, she chants all the mantras with open eyes.

GAMES

Shubechha is a healthy and energetic girl who always co-operates with everybody. She likes to play all the games. She not only does not complain about anybody but also does not fight with her peers. She is happy to play whatever game we ask her to play. She is an intelligent girl and can follow instructions quite well.

LANGUAGE (Hindi)

Shubechha likes to sing the songs with animals in them and with actions. She has learnt many songs, but she takes time to memorise new



songs. Her voice is very soft and clear. She likes the song, “hum honge kamyab”. Her pronunciation is proper except for a few words. She likes to listen to stories narrated with big and colourful pictures. If didi asks

any questions she gives the answer but takes time in responding. She hesitates to give answers when she is in a group. Sometimes she faces difficulty in understanding the language. She makes drawings and then tries to create short stories of 5 or 6 lines. For her language development, we have encouraged her to take part in some short plays. She remembers her lines quickly. On Janmashtami, she participated for the first time in a play where she got the role of a narrator and she performed quite well.

MATHEMATICS

Shubechha sits attentively in the group. She has learnt to recognise colours and make patterns with rangometry which she enjoys. She has learnt forward counting till 20 with ganit mala and other objects. She takes more time to learn due to the language problem. She always pronounces twenty as twenteen.



LANGUAGE (English)

Shubechha has improved her pronunciation of English words. She is keen to sing all the songs. She likes to learn new poems and songs. She has learnt two poems, “chai chai coffee coffee” and “Old McDonald had A Farm” and she learnt them very fast. She enjoyed reciting these poems with actions a lot. Although she has a soft voice, it is audible. She likes to listen to all types of stories and is very attentive during storytelling time. She knows the names of colours and the number of objects. She can tell the names of the pictures, if asked. She participated in an English play, “The Enormous Turnip which was performed in the assembly. She got the role of a dog. She learnt

her dialogues very fast. She really enjoyed doing the play because she liked making the sound of a dog. She knows the opposite words and is interested in doing all the activities in the class.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



Shubechha likes to colour the drawings she makes, and she is very neat in her colouring. She likes to draw pictures of mountains, trees, flowers and sun. She has difficulties in paper folding as she is not able to fold paper properly. While doing quilling she rolls the paper with concentration. She is good in pasting in collage. She does her work very patiently but sometime gets distracted seeing

others working. Her fine motor skills have not developed fully as yet. She enjoys dancing with music.

Although she takes a little time to remember her dialogues with proper pronunciation but after practise, she is able to perform very well. She does not have stage fright.
