beautifully and had labelled it. She was very enthusiastic in seeing the pictures from the book, and did so in her free time as well.

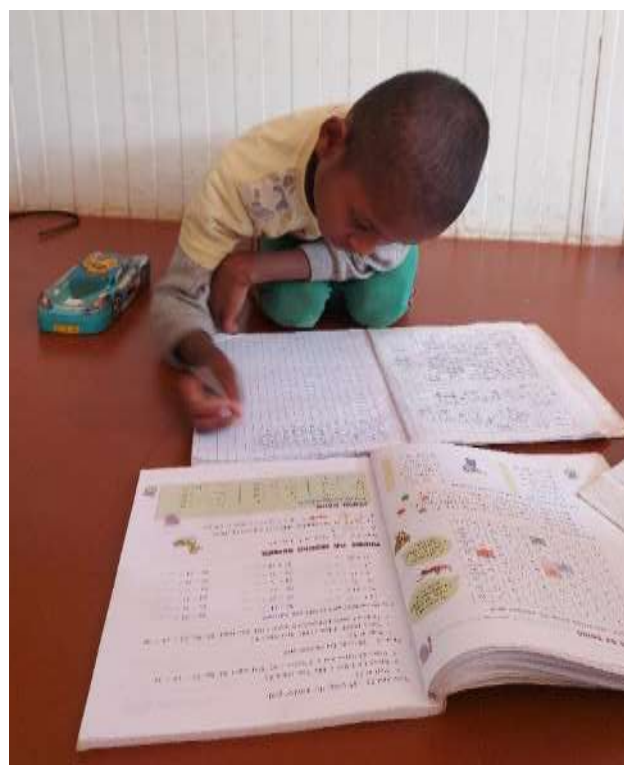
ENGLISH

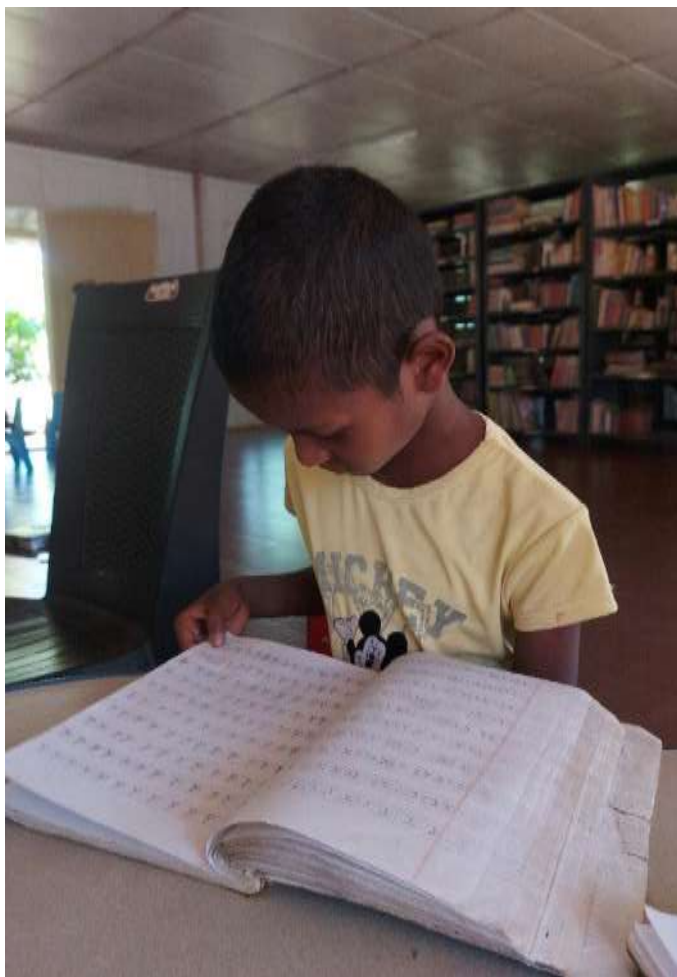
