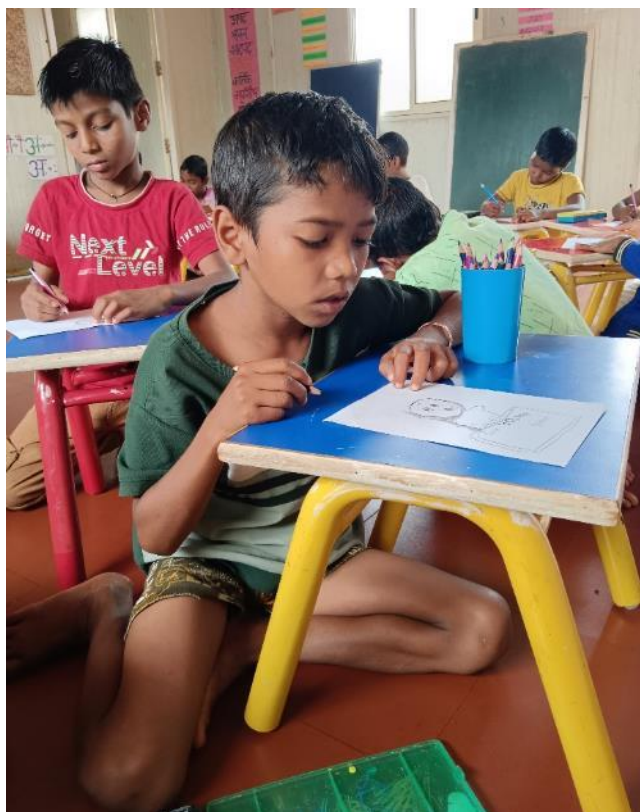
his willingness to engage in learning activities, positions him as a confident and capable learner.
