INTRODUCTION

My name is Pinki Gouda and I am 15 years old. I have just completed my class 10th exams, but I am not satisfied with my marks because I should have got better marks than what I got. I scored 64% in English, 79% in Mathematics, 67% in Science, 56% in Hindi and 53% in Social Science.



I am now in class 12th. I have chosen 5 main subjects - Geography, History, Political Science, English, Physical Education and Yoga and have a practical subject of Yoga assistant. I have started studying on my own and so far, I have not started any online classes. My favourite subject is Social Science. My favourite sport is basketball and I like football too. I like to eat sweets and spicy food. I like chicken but I don't like fish at all.



My board exams kept getting postponed and I was quite bored preparing again and again.

ENGLISH- I have been revising English for my 10th class exam, which I finally wrote in November 2021. As I had completed the English course about a year ago, I was feeling a little bored of repeating the same things again and again. In the English class, we did letter writing, notice writing, paragraph writing, direct and indirect speech, and some grammar. We would do grammar with Bikanti didi. I enjoyed studying grammar with her because she would explain everything 3 or 4 times and when we asked her any question, she would never say no to us. In the class, we solved the previous year questions. I solved 4 or 5 papers without referring to the book because I was finding them very easy as I had answered them many times earlier. We also wrote tests of the previous year papers and I would get around 70 %. In November 2021, I had given my class 10th exam. When I first entered the exam hall, I was feeling very nervous fearing that the question paper would be difficult. But I found that it was quite easy, and I knew the



answers. Now I am doing my 12th class and I am studying English on my own. I liked the stories in the book, and I enjoyed reading them. I have recently read a book “Princess of Rome, prisoner of Egypt” which I liked a lot. I like to read books like these because they are very interesting. I actually read quite a lot.

HINDI- I have been revising the subject for my class 10th exam, for which I appeared in November 2021. I had completed my syllabus about 6 months earlier and I had started revising for my board exam. I studied Hindi with Vidyottma didi. I did my question-answers




and then Didi would tell me to do grammar from the other books in the library. I find Hindi a little difficult to read as compared to English; in writing also, I find Hindi a little difficult because we have to put so many mantras and lines for each word. In Hindi class too, we solved previous years’ question-papers by taking the help of the book – in total, we solved 5 papers each and got them checked by our teacher. Sometimes, we memorized the antonyms and synonyms with a partner, and we would test each other or give the answer to our teacher. Once our teacher gave us a

previous year question paper as a test, in which I obtained 83 out of 100. When I went into the exam hall and saw the question paper, I felt that it was easy, and I knew the answers for most questions. But when I was writing the answers, my hand was paining.

SOCIAL SCIENCE

I had been revising the syllabus for my Social Science exam for which I appeared in November 2021. In the class, I solved the previous years’ question-papers with the help of the book because I did not know some of the answers. We did our class with Bhavna didi. Sometimes she asked us questions from the previous years’ question papers and I tried my best to give the answer in full sentences. We saw movies in the class about the reformers like Jyotiba Phule and Swami Vivekananda and got more information about them. When I first saw the question paper in the exam, I felt it was a little difficult and I was not able to solve some questions I left them. I found the Social Sciences paper a little difficult.



In Social Science, I found Political Science a little difficult and liked Geography the most. That’s why I took Geography in class 12 also but now I find it a bit tough. I also find the Political Science of Class 12 a little difficult but I am trying to learn it. After Geography, I like History the most. In 12th class, I have taken all three subjects. I like


to study History because I get to know about many things that had happened in the past and I find it very interesting.

MATHS- I have been doing Maths revision for my class 10th exam because I had finished the course 3 months before the exam. I did my Math class with Srinath bhaiya and I enjoyed it because Bhaiya would explain everything to us very nicely. I solved 5 previous years' question-papers and I solved some of the questions by taking help from the book, but I solved most questions myself. After solving the paper, our teacher would give tests from the previous years' papers – in the one which I attempted, I got 65 out of 85 marks. I enjoy Maths. I like to do the trigonometry because I liked to put the formulae and solve the equations but I was not able to solve some of the word problems as I was not able to



understand some of the questions. I did my Math class during the shramdan in the morning from 6:30 to 7:30. I had my math exam as the last paper and I had 10 days to revise, so every day I used to memorize the formulas because I had forgotten them. I liked the geometry part the most because I enjoyed doing it and it was a lot of fun. I had revised the geometry part very nicely but not a single question had come from this chapter. Overall, I was not able to solve two questions in the paper.

SCIENCE - During these last 6 months, I have been revising Science subjects for my exam and I appeared for my exam in November. I had finished the book about 6 months before so these days I was only revising the course. In the class, we solved the previous years' question papers and got it checked by Meeta (Bisen) didi. I did not like to study with her because she would scold us a lot. After Mita didi stopped coming, we started revising and giving the tests. In the tests, sometimes I would get good marks and sometimes bad marks. We also gave 3 tests from the previous years' question papers. Later, I studied Science with Ambika didi and Jagat bhaiya. I liked studying with them because they taught us very nicely and I could understand them. I revised from the notes which our teachers had given because they were very easy to understand. When I had gone to give my Science paper and I saw the paper, I realized that I knew most of the answers, but I could not solve 2 or 3 questions. There was a question that asked us to make the diagram of nitrogen cycle and explain it - I could not explain it properly and I only drew the diagram.





SHRAMDAN- As mentioned above, I used to go to study Maths during shramdan which starts at 6:30 am and gets over at 7:30 am. After that I would go for breakfast. After the exam, I again started to do shramdan. In shramdan, I do toilet cleaning, gardening, kitchen, hostel cleaning, school cleaning and on every Sunday, we do our room cleaning as there is no shramdan on Sunday. I like to all the shramdan except gardening - still I do not say anything and do properly the things which I am asked to do. I like to do shramdan a lot. When I was going to study in the morning in the shramdan time, I missed it a lot.



GAMES - Earlier, our games used to start at 3:30 pm and get over at 4:30 pm but ever since the summer season has started, we changed our timetable and made it 4:00 to 5:00 pm because it was very hot at 3:30 and we could not play our games properly. I like the new timetable. We start our games with a little prayer and then we take about 10 rounds of the football field. After that, we do some exercises and then we go for our own corners.



We play volleyball, basketball, frisbee, minor games and football. I like to play basketball the most and it is my favourite game. After that, I like football the most.




