Mathematics- Kirti shows a keen interest in learning mathematics and enjoys it. She actively seeks assistance when necessary and attempts to solve as many questions as possible on her own. She remains attentive during explanations and completes her work quietly. Currently studying the 3rd class book of New Composite Mathematics since December, she has completed 7





chapters, including Fractions, which were covered in group sessions. While she has completed all the question answers from the book and demonstrates clarity in concepts such as like, unlike, proper, improper, and mixed fractions, she faced confusion during a recent test, scoring 8/13. Although she performs well in topics like Numbers (up to ten thousand), Addition, Subtraction, and Problems in addition, she requires further clarity in Roman Numerals. Additionally, while she can perform addition and subtraction of more than two digits with ease and solve word problems on addition accurately, sometimes takes time to understand complex questions.

Projects- Kirti is a very quiet child who doesn't talk much but is active during class. Although she is not always able to answer questions asked to her, she does her best and succeeds. She could identify the different parts of the cycle. She made drawings of cycles and wrote about their history.



step outside her comfort zone.






