Report for 2023-24 (Second Term)

Mathematics- Rahul shows a keen interest in mathematics. While he takes time





to grasp the concepts and questions, he perseveres until he understands them. Occasionally, he hesitates to for ask clarification. Currently studying the Class 3 book of New Composite Mathematics, he began his studies in this book on November 2nd. So far, he has covered 7 chapters, including Numbers (up to thousand), ten Roman numerals, Addition, Subtraction, Problems on addition, and Fractions, and is focusing now on Multiplication. Initially unfamiliar with fractions, he gradually gained understanding through group activities and games, particularly enjoying fraction games with friends.

Although he struggled with concepts such as equivalent fractions, mixed fractions, addition, subtraction, and simplification, he received additional support to clarify these concepts. Despite facing difficulties, he managed to solve all the questions from the book and scored 11/31 in the Fractions test. While he demonstrates clarity

in previous chapters, he struggles with Roman Numerals, Fractions, and Problems on addition due to language barriers. He would benefit from revising the chapter on Roman Numerals and practicing fractions extensively.

Projects- Rahul enjoyed the bicycle topic because he was curious about bicycles and how many types there are in the world. In class, he takes a little time to answer questions but tries his best. He participated in the story group and created an interesting story about bicycles. He also made a beautiful drawing of a bicycle.

Time Topic: Rahul approached the Time project with curiosity and a desire to understand concepts related to time and clocks. He actively engaged in group discussions, asking questions to clarify his doubts and seeking answers to his queries.



However, there were instances where he seemed distracted and lost in thought, indicating a need for sustained focus during class sessions.



Despite occasional lapses in concentration, Rahul demonstrated enthusiasm and participation in the project activities. He eagerly participated in discussions and attempted to answer questions, even if he was unsure of the answers. His active involvement in activities such as shadow marking and sand clock modeling indicated his interest in hands-on learning experiences.

Through his participation in the Time project, Rahul gained valuable insights into the invention of clocks, the difference between time and clocks, and the importance of punctuality. He recognized the significance of organizing tasks and managing time effectively, which led to positive changes in his habits and behaviour.

Flower Topic: In the Flower project, Rahul found enjoyment in activities such as making juice from hibiscus flowers with his friends. Despite finding certain concepts challenging, such as understanding the parts and functions of flowers, he persevered and sought clarification by asking questions and actively listening during class discussions.

and enthusiasm for the topic. His engagement in various project activities and willingness to learn demonstrated his commitment to academic growth and development.


Overall, Rahul's participation in both the Time and Flower projects reflected his curiosity, determination, and willingness to learn. With continued support and

During his study of these books, Rahul demonstrates initiative in attempting to solve accompanying questions, albeit often seeking assistance from the teacher. Nevertheless, he displays commendable consistency in having his notebook checked regularly, indicating a commitment to academic accountability.

Although Rahul's writing skills may require improvement, his efforts to enhance his writing are evident. Furthermore, his willingness to learn and participate in extracurricular activities is



showcased through his successful memorization and performance of a song on 25th December. Additionally, his contribution of a beautiful story for bookmaking on 21st February underscores his creative abilities and imaginative thinking.
