I like to do computers, and listen to songs. I like to read comedy books and the names are astrix oblix. I like to read because it is very funny. My friends are Bhuvan, Kamllochan, Jagat And Lulu. I like to play football. I like to make Besan Ladoos.

This year I want to develop that to come in time to the class and to listen to my elders and to obey my teachers.

One day when I was small I went to the drain. I was washing my hand and leg, a snake came and it rounded my neck. I called Rachana's father. He came and killed the snake, then I went home. After some days we did puja and I was also given some medicine.

His stories are nice and usually comical, where he relates his day to day experiences.

Reads pretty fluently, getting stuck at tougher words.

His speaking has gradually become better and was confident during the drama.

Likes to shout and sing.

He has a miniscule way of writing but it is neat. If he is not in a mood to write, then it is almost illegible.

He does his work well but sometimes tends to roam around aimlessly.

His writing has some funny content and he produces consistent work.

HINDI LANGUAGE - Damru does Hindi readying with full attention.

He listens carefully and writes in dictation, but at times he makes mistakes in using matras.

He thinks and writes.

He likes reading all kinds of comics.

He focuses and tries to understand. Sometimes he has to be explained again.

He is being encouraged to listen and write carefully for improving his spellings.





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PROJECTS - Damru reads books with correct pronunciation. His comprehension is also good. But he has problem in writing. He makes lots of spelling mistakes. Even though he copies from the board or book he does mistakes. He is very much interested in science as well as social science though he takes time to understand the concepts.

He took interest in recognizing different mountains near the school and in drawing their pictures. On seeing pictures of earth and evaporation of molten lava, he slowly understood.

Desert: Before stating the desert topic he learnt about the geography of the earth such as Poles, Hemispheres, Climate Zones, Tropics And The Equator. He has good comprehension skill.

Whenever he is asked to read a social science or science related book and given questions on those, he writes correct answers. He has good thinking ability as he made good questions about deserts and found the answers from the books in the library.

Whenever he does not understand any meaning or concept he immediately tries to gain clarity.

He faced problem in understanding the formation of deserts. Pictorial explanation helps him a lot. Through experiments, drawings, and role play he was clear.





SANSKRIT LANGUAGE - He reads properly. He is making small words and sentences.

Mostly he is not able to comprehend a concept on being explained once. He has to be explained again. He makes mistakes in the verb to be used.

ODIA LANGUAGE - Damru comes to the group with solid excuses. He does not worry about learning Odia. Most of things he cannot think and express. In spite of all this he can read and write a little. We are giving him individual attention for better progress.

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GAMES AND SPORTS - Damru loves Football and puts in a lot of effort to improve his game. He has improved his stamina, speed and also kicking power. His small size was a disadvantage but now he has turned the tables and he escapes with the ball and scores some nice goals. Good at defense.
