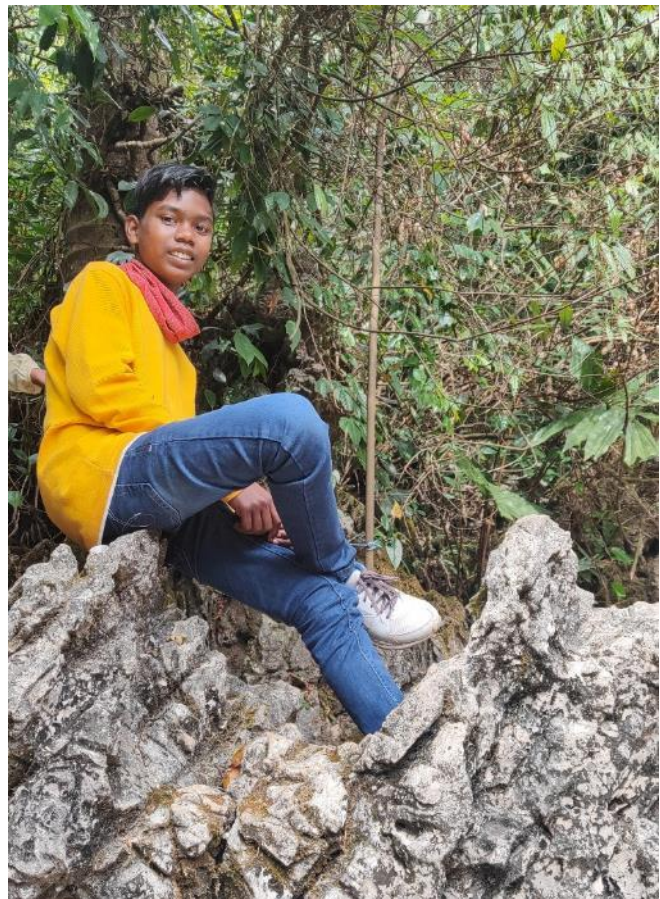

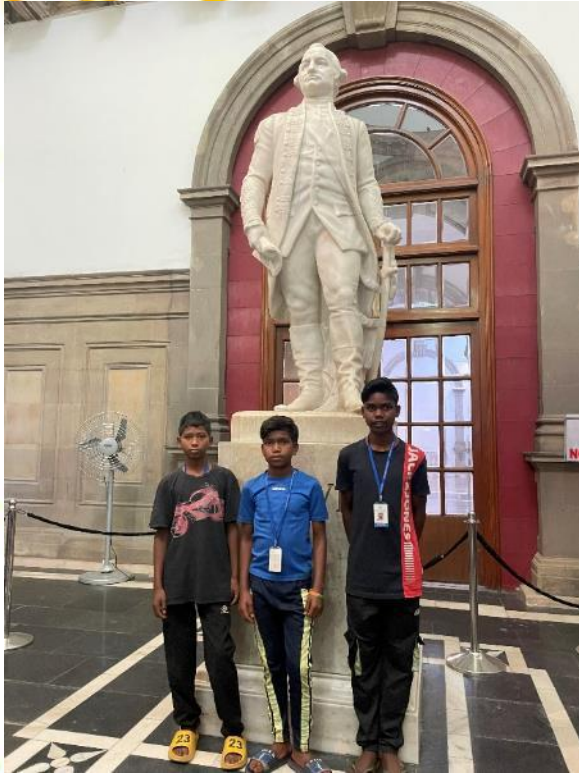

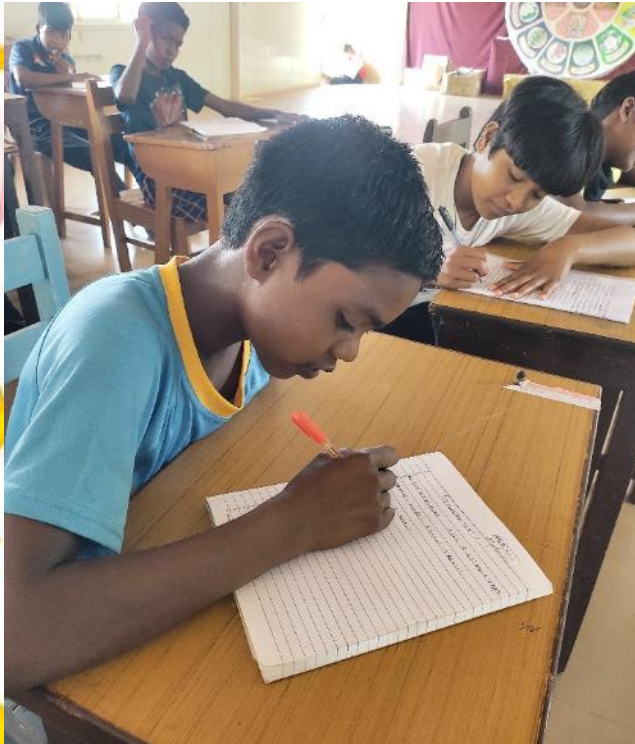








### **Hindi:**



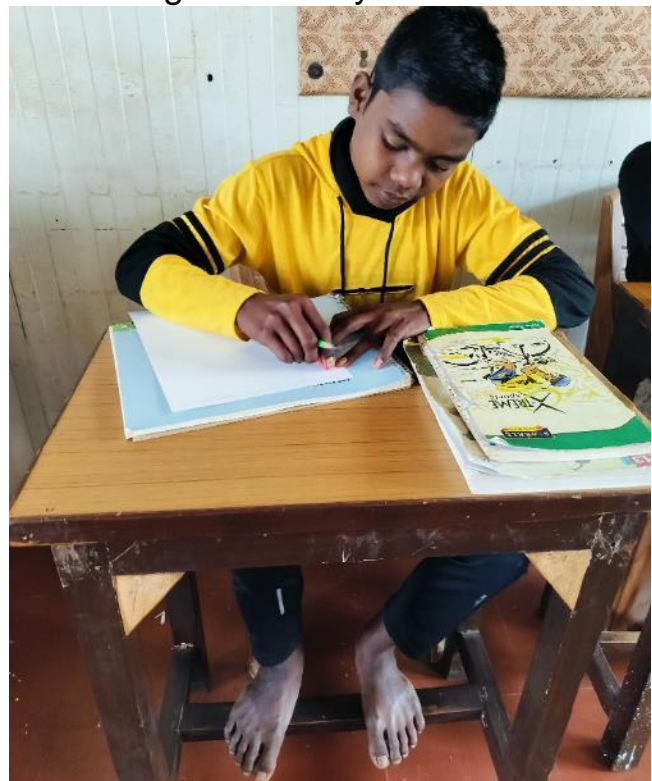
