She has learnt many chants and songs. She chants well with her eyes closed. Her voice is clear and soft.



GAMES

Tapaswini is a silent and disciplined girl. She does all the exercises and plays the games very nicely. Her best friend is Madhurika with whom she likes to play the most. However, her speed and stamina are improving slowly as she is not regular in the class. While running or playing she doesn't run much and keeps standing. Her favourite games are: "Tom and Jerry", "Blind-fold chella" and she like to play with balls the most.

Language (Hindi)

In Circle time, Tapaswini likes to sing all the songs with action. She likes the song "Stuti Aradhana". She feels very happy while singing and she learns new songs very quickly. She likes to listen to stories that are narrated using big picture books. While the story is being told, she sits properly and listens but after sometimes, she starts playing with her limbs and disturbs her friends. When some questions are asked, she can't answer it. But she can create stories in 4 to 6 lines by herself by making drawings. For her language development, she has started participating in enacting some short plays. She is able to remember the lines easily and



her pronunciation is good, but she speaks very softly. When she does the play, her action is very cute and nice.

LANGUAGE (English)



Tapaswini has improved her pronunciation. She likes to sing rhymes and songs, but she sings softly. She has learnt two rhymes – “Chai chai, coffee coffee” and “Old Mac Donald had a farm”. She enjoyed singing these rhymes a lot. She has also learnt the action of these rhymes. She likes to listen to stories - she likes to hear big picture book stories. She can tell the names of the pictures that are

shown. She knows the basic concepts like opposite words. She did a play “The enormous turnip”, in which she had taken the role of a pig and liked to make the pig’s sound. She learnt her dialogues very fast and enjoyed doing this drama very much.



MATHS



She sits in the class very nicely without disturbing anybody. She has learnt forward counting till 20 and also “after and before numbers” till 20 with objects. However, she doesn’t pay attention in the class and takes time to remember. She learnt the colours and helped to make rainbow by colouring the papers with her friends.
