I thoroughly enjoy sports, especially football, where I find joy in scoring goals and kicking the ball high. Additionally,

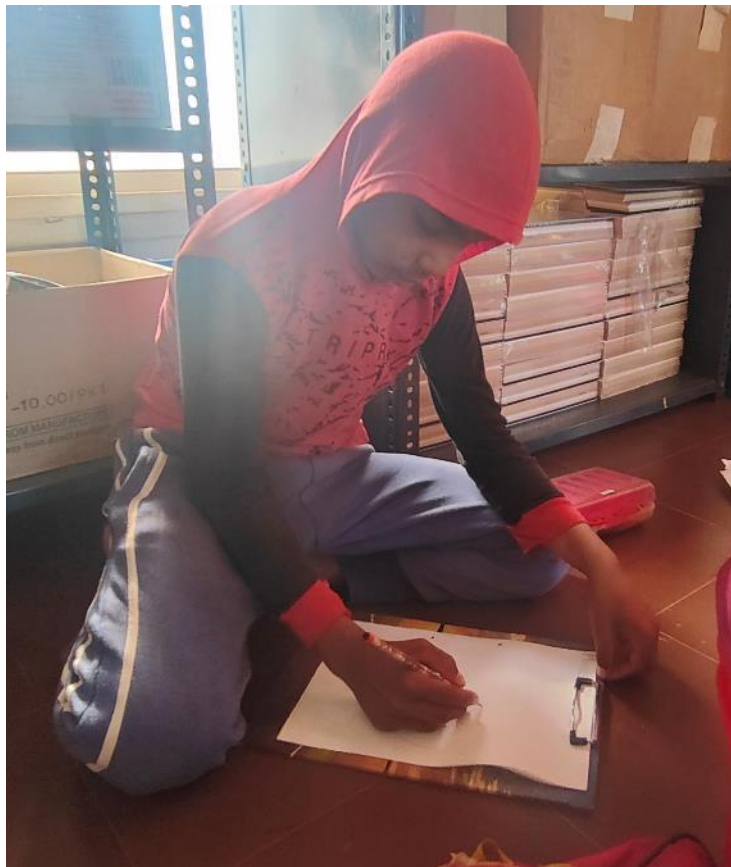


basketball is another favourite due to its scoring opportunities. I actively participate in various other games such as volleyball, dodgeball, base kickball, hide and seek, and kho-kho.
