Despite these challenges, Kusum shows promise. With more practise and encouragement, she will continue to improve in writing, spelling and handwriting. She is a bright student, and with consistent effort, she will do well in her studies.

Hindi: Kusum has successfully completed the 2nd book and is



now doing the 3rd book of GUNJAN. She is also doing grammar- 2nd book. In grammar she learnt some basic concepts like- VARNA VICCHED, SWAR, VYANJAN, Etc. When she works from a book, she first understands the lesson and then answers the questions by herself. If she does not understand anything, she asks and gets her notebook checked every day. She likes to read different types of stories, and she tells good stories, but makes silly mistakes while writing the story. She writes clearly, and her reading has improved. Projects: Kusum is a very shy child and only speaks when she is asked to. She has to work more in order to progress. She can do better with a little more attention

She is gradually understanding the concept of a leap year.

Kusum learnt how to measure the length of objects using a scale. She understood that Metre is made up of 100 centimetres and could explain it clearly. Whenever



she needed to convert one unit to another, she thought very deeply about the process. It took her some time to fully grasp the conversion between kilometre and metre, but with practise, she figured it out.
