She understood the pattern of roman numerals and was able to convert Arabic numerals to Roman numerals. We revised measurement. She knows which unit will be used for measuring volume, weight and length. She has learnt the Indian and International place values. She is able to read and write the number names of 8 digits. In fraction, she is able to recognize unit fraction, like fraction, unlike fraction, proper fraction, improper fraction and mixed fraction. She can arrange the unit fraction, like fraction in ascending and descending order. While solving word problems, she reads the problem and understands the concept of addition and subtraction with ease but in multiplication, division she needs help.
