English

Maths

swift when it comes to one-digit addition, and she can handle one-digit addition with two-digit numbers both mentally and using objects. Vaishali is also progressing in the concept of 'more' and 'less,' attempting to distinguish between quantities. She displays an ability to comprehend and solve word problems.



She needs to concentrate more in class. She has successfully performed addition of one digit by one digit, two digits by one digit, and two digits by two digits. Initially, she tackled addition using objects such as bundles and sticks, progressing to performing the operations without objects. While she has a grasp on addition, she finds the two-digit by two-digit addition challenging without the aid of objects. Her understanding of numbers, both before and after, as well as the relationships between them, is clear. She also demonstrates a good understanding of "more than" and "less than," but she needs to build confidence in her abilities.

She has been introduced to subtraction, and she successfully tackled small numbers ranging from one to ten with confidence and without fear. She excels at skipping numbers by twos, both with and without objects. To reinforce her understanding, she benefits from repetition, and she particularly grasps concepts better when presented through stories.

Arts

Vaishali's drawings predominantly feature animals and forest scenes, which she adorns with gentle, well-executed colouring. Her proficiency in paper folding is evident as she can complete these tasks





independently. Her choice of green as her favourite colour aligns with her nature-inspired artwork.

Puzzles

Vaishali is another quiet and focused puzzle solver, demonstrating her ability to handle puzzles with piece counts between 100 and 150. She often chooses to work alone and finds genuine interest and satisfaction in her puzzle-solving endeavours.
