PRATIK:



The first half of the year, he did not come to school regularly, that is why he hardly learnt anything in school.

In **Human body** topic, he studied the internal as well as external parts of our body.

He took a long time to remember the new words related to the topic. He needed help in reading the flash cards.

He also tried to understand the functions and parts of different systems of our body. He could present about one system in front of his friends.





IN ANIMALS TOPIC, he learnt about the classifications of animals based on eating habits as well as their habitat.

He liked drawing the pictures more than writing on chart. He made a story and used puppets in storytelling. He took a long time to remember his lines.

Most of the times Prateek was not present during the celebrations topic, so he did not participate in this topic, songs or in any plays.



He takes part in drama enthusiastically but takes time to remember the dialogues. He needs encouragement to sing English songs. He has learnt few songs.

<u>Матн:</u>

Prateek was not regular for half of the year. So he has not covered many concepts. He picks up the concepts easily. He is good in doing addition and subtraction mentally. Now he is doing math from book-2.

He can solve word problems with one explanation. He is able to do 2 digits addition and subtraction with carrying and borrowing.

He has leant the spellings of months and days, number names till 1000. He can arrange numbers in ascending order.





He can also do simple multiplications by doing repeated addition. In measurements, he has learnt the units- cm, m, kg, g, ml, l of volume, capacity and mass. He can tell the time shown on the clock.

He could also understand the pattern of Roman Numerals but sometimes forgets. If he will concentrate, he will do better. He can identify Indian coins and notes and easily convert small amounts of rupees into paisa.

<u>Hindi</u>

He is a slow learner. So he needs individual attention. He makes lots of mistakes while taking dictation. He is still learning how to use matras.

He is doing class 1 book. He tries to read simple words but sometimes finds it difficult. He loves listening to stories and is less distracted during that time. His handwriting is good.
