## HINDI:

Muskan exhibits a calm and attentive demeanour in the classroom, displaying a genuine enthusiasm for storytelling, writing, and reading activities. Despite facing initial challenges in learning letters, she persevered and successfully mastered all of them, now confidently writing words without matras. Muskan's dedication to learning is evident, as she invested considerable time in familiarizing herself with letters and gradually honing her skills.



However, Muskan encounters difficulties with certain letter pronunciations, particularly with sounds like "khh," "shh," and "BH." Additionally, she requires more time to memorize songs and poems, often singing softly during recitations. confused with matras, indicating a need for further practice and reinforcement.

Participation in a class play, where Muskan portrayed the role of a baby goat, highlights her willingness to engage in various activities despite challenges. Despite finding it challenging to learn Hindi numbers, she managed to learn up to 25, showcasing her determination and perseverance.
