Report for 2022-23 (first term)



English

To improve their understanding and to speak in English, the teachers made them hear many stories. The stories are like-



The boy who cried wolf, the giant snake, a little bit of winter, the ugly duckling, the little red riding hood, the flying trunk,

the king Midas and his golden touch, the shoemaker and the



elves, the selfish giant, pied piper, the three little pigs, the little Krishna, Ganesha, the enormous turnip, shoe maker and the elves, three little

pigs. The children also spoke about themselves. They learnt songs like London Bridge, colour song, deep deep, together we are a family, sing sing a song. They also learnt rhymes like are you sleeping, clap your hands, tommy thumb. They performed dramas on some of the stories they heard, like the enormous turnip, shoemaker and the elves, three little pigs. They also learnt poems like tree and God.



The children did many programmes like on 5th July they presented a play- Goldilocks and the three bears and a dance 'I like to move it'. On 15th August- recitation of poem God and

a dance “bharat hamko jaanse pyara he” taught by Denis bhaiya. On Ganesh Chaturthi- A drama on the little Ganesha’s wisdom

Math



During these six months they have done lots of activities like playing with rongometry, jodo cubes and aakar parivar. Using these materials they had made patterns and shapes. They also segregated the shapes according to their colours, shapes and sizes. Using aakar parivar they had recognised the shapes and had arranged the shapes in ascending and descending order. They also did an activity of putting the missing shapes in their correct places. In aakar parivar they had used the shapes in making different designs and patterns. They also did the

counting of the shapes that they have used in the pattern. At first when they were learning counting, they first assimilated till twenty and then they started



counting ahead till hundred. When they were clear in forward counting till hundred they did backward counting from hundred. Some of them were very fast in counting forward and backward. Once they were done with forward and backward counting, they started skip counting of two. When



they got clear in skipping by twos, gradually they started to skip by three, four, five, six and seven. They did addition using objects and a little bit of subtraction. They started addition with one-digit numbers and gradually they did addition till

twenty. They have done these addition and subtraction only mentally. After they got a bit clear in these, they started recognizing the numbers with a song which described the

numbers. It was very interesting for them to learn the numbers with the song, they enjoyed it a lot. They were able to recognise the numbers better with pictures with the numbers. After

learning to recognize the numbers they started

observing the numerals and they started drawing the numerals on the floor. Later they



started writing the numerals with a chalk. At first, they got confused but slowly they all improved. First, they started writing the numbers only till ten but later they wrote till



twenty and then beyond. Before they wrote the numerals, they also played with the *man* cards where they had to show the

numbers which was shown on *ganith mala*. *Man* cards only helped the children to recognise the numbers after twenty.

Projects

Colours



Aim: These children are young in age now so we don't use the textbook to teach them. They learn through playing different



activities in their surroundings.

They didn't know anything about colours. This topic introduce them to colours. They learnt a colour song. After

learning this song, there were some children who were very curious to know about the colours. We have taken this topic in English language. It involves different types of English words and fun activities.



We included many types of activities like colour songs, a story-through seven colours, they made drawings, Collage, watching related topics, wearing clothes, imaginations by themselves, group decorations. All children are enthusiastic and explore their surroundings and identify the colour of various objects. At the end of the class all children can recognise seven colours very confidently. Most of the children spoke the words in English. During this season they practised many other songs and drama for school programmes.

My family



In this topic we focused on developing the thinking of the children by speaking different nomenclature about their family. We focused on speaking in Hindi and English as to what we call them. At times they would listen and after that they would tell the correct relationship with their family members. They are young but they actively participated by pictures and drawings. Through picture, we discussed about their family members and what they call them





and why family is important. They spoke about how their parents make them happy when

they are sad and when they have a problem, they talk to their family/ mother/siblings and how the family works together. Drawing activities, Speaking in full sentence, storytelling, different types of families like nuclear and joint family were discussed. At the end of the topic, most of the children understood what they should call their relatives in English.

Art

Victory group children are very much interested in art class.



They enjoy doing every activity. In 6 months, they have improved a lot in art. They know how to cut paper, how to draw, how to fill colour in the pictures and colour

combinations. Their drawing is very good. They don't spread the colour out of the picture, they fill it with bright colours.



While doing any cutting and pasting activities a few face some difficulty, so they need help to cut the paper, though most of the children are able to cut paper by themselves. A few children don't know how to hold the scissors. In six months, they learnt whatever was taught very eagerly. They made snail, hanging craft, they did painting of a tree with lot of birds which were of different colours, paper leaves and flower vase by themselves. They all concentrated while doing and were happy to do it, they always finished the work in the given time.
