She shows enthusiasm for classroom activities but takes time to understand concepts. Now she is doing book three. She able to

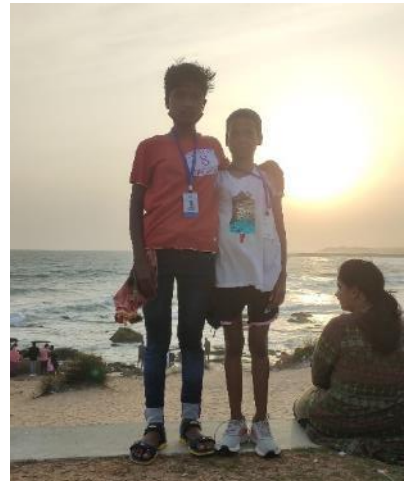

## English



Dhatri has improved in her reading. She can now read the words by breaking them. She does not try to speak in English. She needs the help of the teacher to read some of the words. She rarely speaks in the class. On fifth July she danced *sawar loon*. It was her first dance, so it was difficult for her to pick up the steps. She took time in learning the dance. But she tried to do her best. In the drama 'the tree and the woodcutter'



she took the character of woodcutter. The lines were difficult for her to remember. She had difficulty in pronouncing the words. To do acting also she took many days to learn. During the performance she was not clear. She was feeling nervous. Surrender poem was difficult to remember. She made effort to learn it. Sunday poem was also difficult, but she remembered it gradually and performed it beautifully.

She needs to concentrate a lot in the class. She is sometimes restless. She issues books from the library to read in her spare time. She is active in the group whenever we are doing some reading. She tries to catch up with the other children in the group, if she gets behind. She tries to do her homework on time. In grammar she has learnt the vowels, nouns, verbs, articles, adjectives, and adverbs. Now she is doing book two of the good grammar. Once it has been

explained, she can read it by herself and can do all the exercises. If she is confused, she always asks. She has improved her

handwriting very much, but she needs to be very conscious about putting the capital letters and full stops.

## Hindi



She is improving in her reading. Her writing is good, but she needs to improve her spellings and she is confused about the matras. She is doing grammar book of 4<sup>th</sup> class. When she understand the steps then she is able to solve the question easily. She has finished some chapters and is facing difficulties in pronouns and nouns. She is fond of the chapter on gender. She is now attempting the Abhyaspustak of class 3<sup>rd</sup>. When is attentive in the class, she doesn't need help, but when she is not attentive she asks for help again and again. She tries to give the answer to the questions which are asked. Her creative writing is not so good, but she really tries to write with imagination.
