Mathematics

of a jackfruit and some other summer fruits, which she loves to



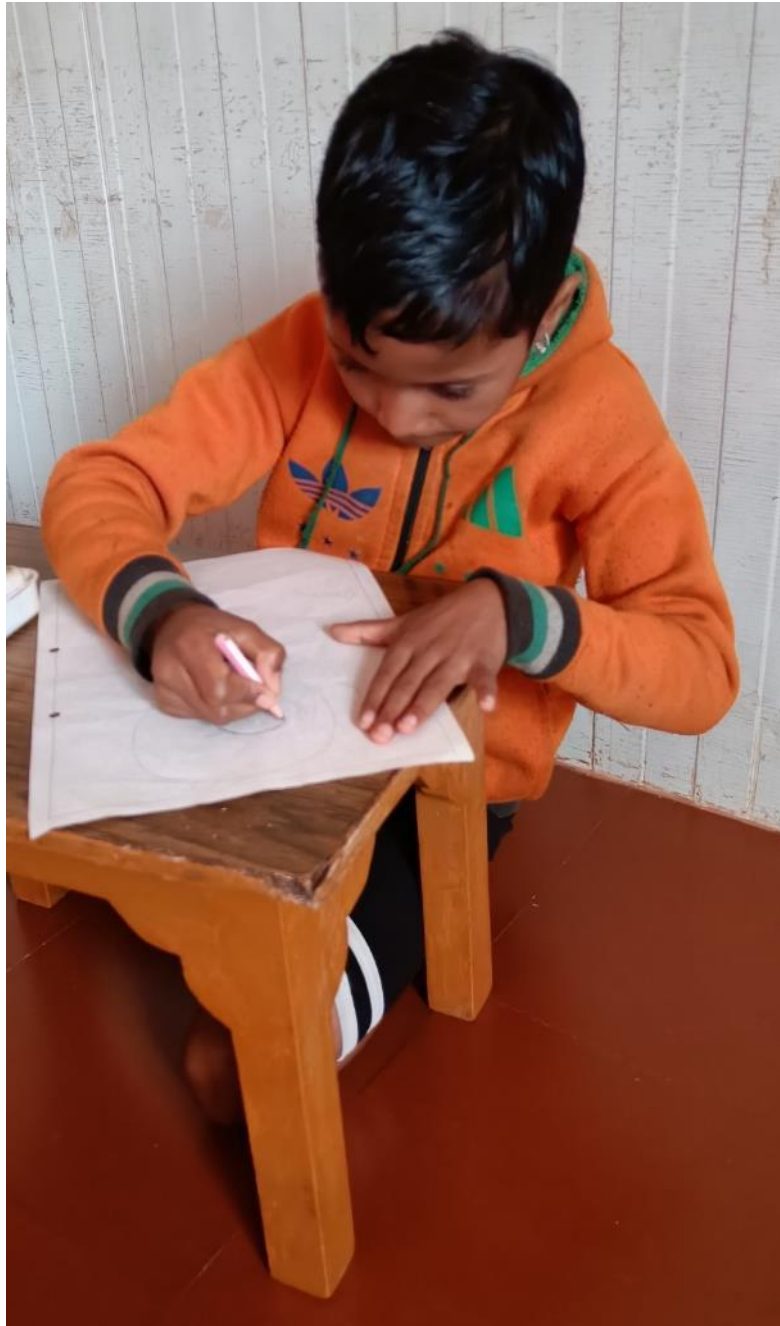
eat. She participated in a play related to the topic where she played the role of a student who tells how we should eat the various fruits along with their benefits.
