

Annual Report of New Creation Group

2020-21

All the students of New Creation Group have completed class 10th and are preparing for their class 12th and will be completing their class 12th while they are in this group. After completing their class 10th, they take a call whether they would like to continue staying here or they would like to go out to some other school and study. The decision is also taken by the school where the teachers and the senior students decide whether the student who is wanting to stay on



is disciplined enough and self-motivated to stay on. The amount of freedom there for senior students, the fluid timetable with many of the classes being held online and also the small number of students can be a boon for some and a bane for others.

There are 11 students in this group. At the beginning of the year, we had only Neela, Mansi, Sushila, Mohan and Mad humay. During the year Basanti, Swati, Niraj, Brishti, Sumitra and Jayu completed their 10th and expressed their desire to stay on.

In NIOS, one can start appearing for exams a year after taking admission. However, the student cannot complete the course by appearing in their 5th



subject till 2 years are over from the date of clearing class 10th. Neela, Mohan and Mansi have cleared 3 papers each. They will be completing their 12th in the coming year.

Students who are in this group have selected their subjects on their own. The children are studying individually or in small groups. Some subjects are common

such as English. The subjects range from Science to Humanities. Some students have only core subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, History, Geography, etc. Others have taken a mix of core and soft subjects. Most of the subjects are taught online by teachers who have volunteered. They students are also given questions to solve and practise tests.



The students participate in all activities that are common to the school like-Shramdan, sports, assembly, yogasana and meditation.



They participate in all festivals, programmes and functions. For example on Pranjal bhaiya's birthday some of them, such as Swati, Brishti and Neela danced on a song 'Ghungroo toot gaye, and 'yaar mera titliyan ban ja'. On New Year they danced on a song 'Illegal Weapon and Muqabala'. On The Mother's birthday



some of them such as Brishti, Jayu, Sumitra and Swati participated in a drama written by The Mother- 'Ascent to Truth'.

During Shramdan they are divided into groups and help the younger children by showing them how to do the work and also by setting an example.



During sports, they play together with the other younger children. They show them how to play the games according to the rules of the game. The younger children learn and also enjoy themselves. They demonstrate the exercises so that the other children who are with them also follow them.

Everyone participated in the sports day. They joined in all the corners and enjoyed it very much. Most of the boys liked the athletics part very much and the girls liked the basketball and football matches. They practised rigorously for the high jump and long jump. The obstacles corner was really fun for all of them.





Even though they looked easy, but it was difficult for them to complete all the items. They all missed the physical demonstration, which was not held this year as we were in lockdown and outsiders were not allowed.



The yogasan period, which is at 6 in the morning, is taught to them by Anni didi. Many asanas are demonstrated by her, and they follow her and enjoy doing it. Most of them reach on time.

They are disciplined most of the time. They guide and motivate each other. They understand that their performance in 12th will make a difference in deciding what they will be doing after this. Also, if they are too lax, they will not be completing their 12th in 2 years and will be wasting precious time.
