Maths

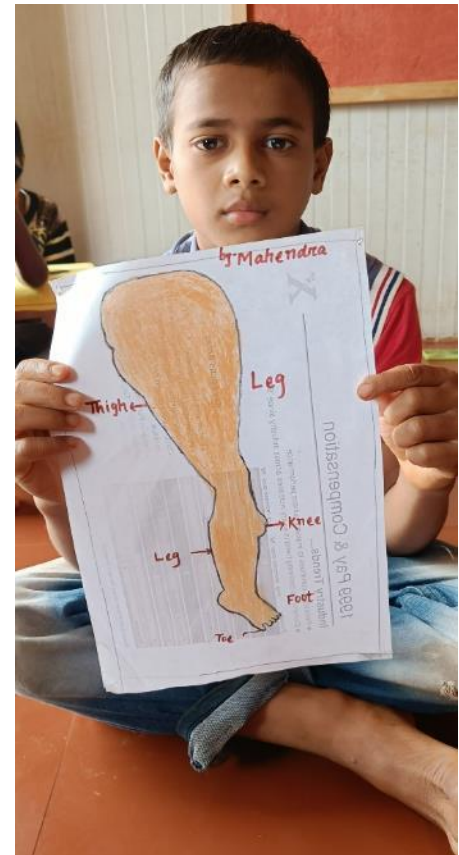

He learnt the colours, shapes and sizes of all the fruits which are around him and saw how many seeds are present in each fruit. Earlier he could

Earlier he did not know the names of fruits in English except for a few like mango/ guava, but after doing this topic, he could remember quite a few names.
