Mathematics

She has started counting by touching different objects and beads. Saiti can count up to 5 by observing a ganit mala, but beyond 5, she relies on touching the objects. She can count numbers till 100 in one go, with some confusion in transitional numbers like 50, 60, and 70.

She likes to colour pictures in art class, paying attention to colouring within the lines and keeping the paper clean. She prefers drawing her family and, despite working slowly, aims to complete her work beautifully. Her favourite colour is red, and she colours her drawings darkly.
