Maths

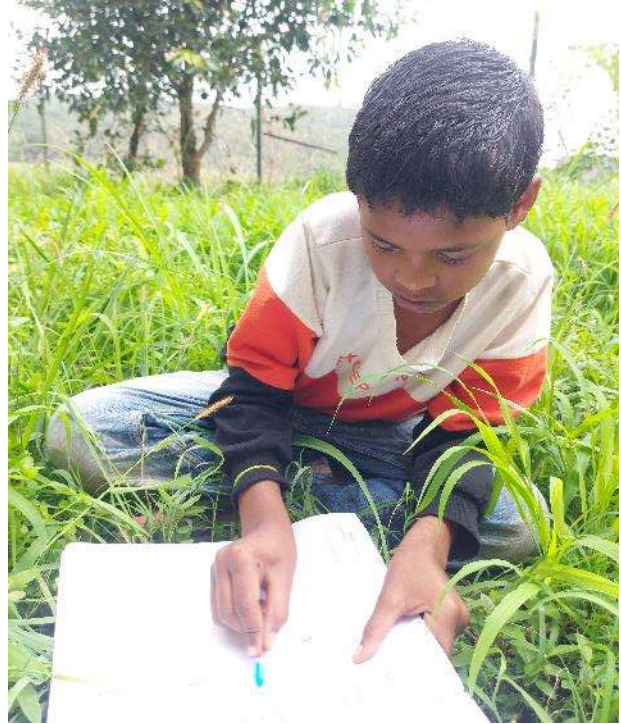
